- 1.) By submitting a Student Application/Registration Form, the applicant agrees to the following terms and conditions. Student applications will only be processed for membership upon student's acceptance of the following terms and conditions without alteration.
- 2.) By agreeing to the following terms, it is understood that as a member or affiliate of Ironbear Martial Arts L.L.C., you will be exposed to techniques and training that could prove harmful or deadly to either yourself or other individuals.
- 3.) In and effort to promote a professional image of Ironbear Martial Arts L.L.C, I will conduct myself professionally so as to reflect positively on myself, my school, and other affiliates of which I may be associated while training at Ironbear Martial Arts L.L.C. While wearing Ironbear apparel/accessories (sweatshirts, patches, etc.), discussing my affiliation with Ironbear Martial Arts L.L.C and attending a martial arts function, I will maintain a positive image consistent with that of a professional martial artist.
- 4.) At times, Ironbear Martial Arts L.L.C publications (newsletters, website, face book etc.) may provide names, pictures or video and other information about fellow classmates.
- 5.) Contact outside of class is only permitted between members if there is: a) Mutual consent to the discussion; b) No intent to solicit or offer goods and services for a fee; c) No intent to discredit another member, interfere with another member's method of instruction, or lure students to any other school for any reason.
- 6.) In case of disagreement between instructors and any other member, it is understood that as sternly directed the offended party must first privately address the offender to seek restitution for any wrongdoing. If not resolved satisfactorily, the matter should be brought to Ironbear Martial Arts L.L.C. staff for discussion. A proposed resolution will be provided by both parties, as deemed appropriate by the staff. If the root of the problem is found to be inappropriate behavior or lifestyle by a fellow member, immediate termination will be exercised without refund of application, registration, or tuition fees. Reinstatement must be at a minimum of 24 months from the date of termination, subject to acceptance by Ironbear Martial Arts L.L.C. staff.
- 7.) Ironbear Martial Arts L.L.C. reserves the right to refuse membership to anyone based on what the staff defines as "irreconcilable differences." If the personal beliefs of an applicant are considered by the staff as inappropriate and problematic, membership may be refused without recourse or reconsideration as it is not in the interest of either party to pursue the relationship.
- 8.) I understand that by its very nature, martial arts is an activity that will have physical demands
- 9.) As the nature of physical activity has been explained, I accept full responsibility for participation in this activity and any injury resulting from my participation in martial arts. Ironbear martial Arts L.L.C., is in no way at fault as I am fully aware of the risks to which I am exposed by participation in this class; therefore, Ironbear Martial Arts LLC is not responsible for any injury suffered by my training in the arts. By submitting my application for membership, I waive my right to legal recourse against these entities for any damage (liquid or otherwise) caused by such an injury.
- 10.) I understand that I must observe the conditions contained herein with exception to remain in good standing with Ironbear Martial Arts L.L.C.
- 11.) I understand that the classes are provided for a fee; it is my responsibility to render payment on time for the instruction of the current month. Payment must be paid in full by the first Wednesday of every month or which ever payment schedule the particular school is on. I also understand that fees and schedules may change from time to time. If the payment is not received by that date then a late fee will be applied.
- 12.) If I fail to meet my obligations as stated in this agreement, I realize that my membership may be terminated at the sole discretion of Ironbear Martial Arts L.L.C.
